PLAN "B" - "America on Wheels" Museum Tour

On Sunday March 1st, we met up with Russ and Cathy and 10 members from AGWA Chapter B at the Ritz for lunch. After we finished eating we made our way to the east side of town to the America on Wheels Museum. The former A&B Meats Plant site has been converted into quite a modern work of art. Last April they opened their doors to the public for the first time to see a vast collection of all types of transportation. There were Mack trucks, race cars, motorcycles, antique cars, racing lawn mowers and bicycles from the past to all the way into the distant future. They even have a "Pee Wee Herman bicycle" There are a lot of interactive exhibits, such as sitting in the seat of a Mack truck with a virtual driving experience to a small one cylinder gas engine you can disassemble and put back together

again. One thing I would suggest to watch is the "Art Car parade movie" which plays in a mini theater on the first floor.
